

12 MUST-SEE ART SHOWS OPENING THIS WEEK



<u>Mitchell-Innes & Nash</u> (534 West 26th Street) opens the first major painting retrospective in NYC by the late artist Tom Wesselmann on Thursday, April 21, 6 to 8 p.m. The gallery hopes to "show how the artist has filtered the canonical subjects of art -- still life, the nude and the landscape -- through a unique and personal lens."
